The Island of MAUI

Maui is named after the son of Hinaakeahi (Hina of the fire) a prankster demigod known through the Pacific for his superhuman feats. Some of those feats include lifting the sky so people no longer had to crawl on all fours and lengthening the day by lassoing the sun.

Maui enjoyed incorporating trickery in his good deeds. When he was trying to gain the knowledge of fire for mankind he first caught the mud hen, who knew the secret of fire. He told her he would wring her neck until she gave him the secret to fire. She eventually gave him the secret and Maui rubbed her head with the fire stick until all her feathers came off. To this day, the Hawaiian mud hen is bald.

Once a thriving fishing village and the capital city of the Kingdom of Hawaii until 1845, Lahaina now resembles the likes of a small New England town and is now a peaceful and prosperous shopping mecca.

Approximately 55 acres of Lahaina is designated as National Historical Landmarks. The Pioneer Inn, built in 1901 was the first hotel to open here. Lahaina Fort was built in the 1830's and a small part of it has been reconstructed where it stands today. The Carthaginian II is moored at the pier and is a replica of a 19th century square-rigged ship and now home to a whale museum located on the lower decks.
