FANNING ISLAND

Today we invite you to explore the untouched beauty of Fanning Island, in the Republic of Kiribati.

1798 – Captain Edmund Fanning arrives aboard the *Betsy*.

1814 – Several Hundred Gilbertese arrive to work on coconut plantations.

1855 – Captain Henry English begins production of coconut oil.

1877 – Guano phosphate mining exports more than 19,500 tons to Honolulu.

1879 – Copra becomes the main export shipped to Honolulu.

1888 – Annexed to Great Britain as part of the Gilbert and Ellice Island colony.

1902 – Trans-Pacific cable relay station established.

1911 – Nuremberg raiding party blows up cable station.

1979 – Independence of the Republic of Kiribati (Gilbert Islands); Fanning Island is officially named Tabaueran.

1998 – NCL "discovers" Fanning Island and launches 10 day cruises from Honolulu.

2001 – NCL initiates weekly visits from Honolulu and a weekly lifeline for mail, food and school supplies.
